Fall 2020 COVID-19 Policies

Updated 7/28. Subject to change as conditions warrant.

Move-In Policy

- ALL MEMBERS MUST TEST NEGATIVE FOR COVID-19 PRIOR TO MOVING IN. This
 test can be taken within 5 days before move in, but please self quarantine in the days
 leading up to move in after your test
- Proof of negative test must be sent to Risk and Wellness director Nick Kubycheck (630)
 209-1368.
- If a member of your permanent residence has tested positive within the past 14 days you cannot move in until all household members test negative
- We will observe a week-long staggered move-in process to reduce contact between families and others assisting with move-in
- All brothers must get tested once a week. We cannot have events (see below) if brothers do not follow this rule
- Brothers must sign up for a three-hour time slot before move-in. We will offer the following slots every day August 10th through 17th:
 - o 10am 1pm
 - o 1pm 4pm
 - o 4pm 7pm
- A maximum of six families can sign up for each time slot, with a maximum of two brothers moving in per floor
- Each Brother is allowed no more than two people to assist them with moving in
 - No assistance is allowed outside of selected move-in time.
- Everyone will be required to wear face coverings while in the Chapter House

Guest Policy

- A maximum of one guest is allowed per resident at any given time. This means one guest per person in personal rooms and suites as well
- Guests must wear facemasks at all times no matter where they are in the house
- All guests must test negative within 7 days of coming to the house. Any member of the fraternity can ask for proof
- Brothers MUST check their guest in with Nick Kubycheck if they're not a brother

- Brothers who do not live in the house must ask permission to enter suites. Non-residents
 are not allowed to bring guests into the chapter house
- Non-resident brother must text Nick Kubycheck to check themselves in
- Until further notice, all guests must be checked in with Nick Kubycheck upon entrance to
 the house. This will just be a simple text message along the lines of "Hey, i'm bringing
 ______ into the house". The reason for this is so if a case appears, the house can do
 proper contact tracing if need be

House/Sanitization Policy

- House Managers will coordinate and monitor Greek Management to ensure that all surfaces in common areas of the house are cleaned and disinfected daily and with the Caterer so that dining room tables are disinfected after every meal
- Face coverings should be worn in common areas when practical
- The House will purchase contactless thermometers to take the temperature of Brothers and guests
- Hand sanitizer dispensers will be installed in several common areas of the House
- House Managers will maintain a stockpile of the following:
 - Disinfectant wipes
 - Pine-Sol for the floors
 - Mops and mop heads
- Greek Management will keep public bathrooms stocked with hand soap, paper towels, and toilet paper
- Finance Director will allocate extra funds for cleaning supplies
- Sanitation and cleanliness will be emphasized heavily throughout the semester

Sickness Policy

- If a brother tests positive they must IMMEDIATELY alert the chapter president
- If a brother who lives at the house tests positive or comes into contact with someone who tests positive, they should immediately isolate themselves in their personal room
- The infected individual can only leave their personal room to use the bathroom.
- If someone tests positive in the house, all brothers must immediately go get tested
- If a brother tests positive no guests will be allowed in the house until there is a negative test
- If a case occurs no guests will be allowed in the house until all who tested positive test negative
- People who share the suite with an infected brother must all use the opposite bathroom as the infected brother and must not hang out in the suite common area at all.
- The Executive Board will monitor case numbers around campus and may change policies as needed
